As we take a moment to reflect on the many accomplishments of Margaret Mary Health in 2016, we recognize the incredible growth we've experienced. Adding services and improving access to care requires additional resources. To support this growth, this past year MMH added 75 team members, including physicians and specialists, to the medical staff, bringing our total number of employees to 722.

With thoughtful planning on the best way to provide care for our rural communities, we purchased a health center in Brookville, began expansion on our Osgood facility and started plans for a new location in Milan. To complement our maternity services, we added two pediatricians to our medical staff, trained to treat children from birth through adolescence. We positioned these new services and facilities where our patients need them, offering convenience and easier access to specialized care.

As part of our mission to improve the health of our communities, we continue to develop strong relationships with local employers to help improve the health of their employees. Last year we partnered with many businesses, as well as the Southeastern Indiana School Insurance Consortium, to provide customized, patient-centered health care services from wellness and education to on-site screenings, health risk appraisals, immunizations and rehabilitation.

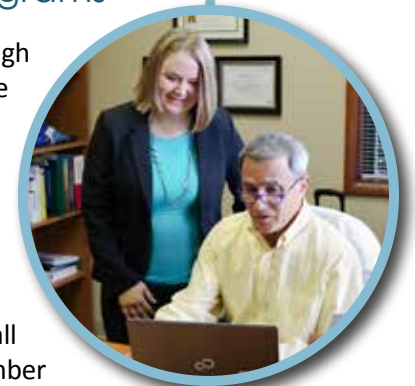

We know healthcare costs are of concern to everyone. That's why we continue to identify ways to eliminate waste, gain efficiency and reduce expenses. Of course, every process improvement and cost-saving initiative must enhance patient safety and quality of care, too.

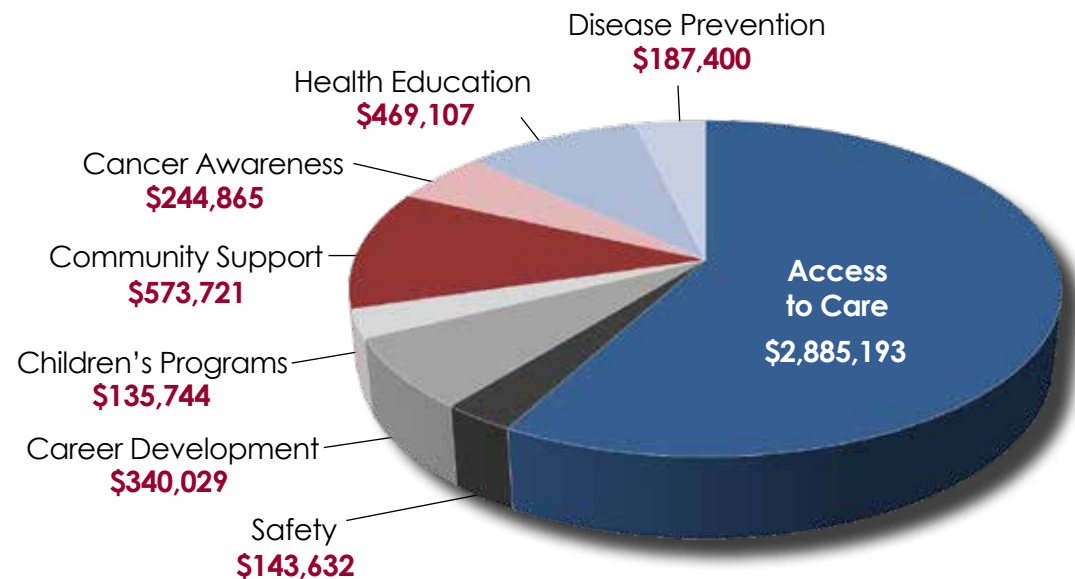

They taught me how to safely stretch and strengthen my shoulder. They were supportive, and I knew if I worked hard, I could recover faster. A 15-minute drive to Batesville also beats not having to drive to the city."

It's been six months since his surgery, but thanks to hard work and his incredible therapy team, Bill has gotten cleared to resume all previous activities.

And it's a good thing because this outdoorsman still has a lot of hunting and fishing to do!

Junior Grimes knows all too well the importance of being in the right place at the right time. Last March, chest pain and shortness of breath landed this 73-year-old Brookville resident in Margaret Mary's emergency services department. He wasn't there long before going into sudden cardiac arrest.

Without hesitation, Margaret Mary's emergency team sprang into action, resuscitating him and using a defibrillator to shock his heart back to a normal rhythm. He was then stabilized and transferred to The Christ Hospital where he underwent angioplasty and had a stent inserted. Margaret Mary is proud to be a member of The Christ Hospital Chest Pain Network.

"I consider myself lucky," said Junior, "I'm so thankful for the doctors and nurses who took care of me that day. They saved my life."

A recent graduate of Margaret Mary's cardiac rehab program, Junior is doing well and now has more energy to enjoy his retirement and run his hunting dogs.
