

NAVIGATING YOUR MARGARET MARY HEALTH PATIENT PORTAL

Need assistance? Call our Patient Portal Helpline at **812.933.5124** to enroll, request an email invitation, reset your password or notify us of missing results, discharge instructions or other medical information.



- 1 Health Record: When clicked, a drop-down displays all information specific to your personal health profile (see sample below).
- Messages: Find messages from (or send nonurgent messages to) your provider's office.
- 3 Appointments: View upcoming appointments.
- 4 Meds Refill: Request a medication refill. If medication cannot be located, you can also type in the medication name along with the prescription number to request a refill. You must answer "How should we contact you if we have questions?" for the request to be submitted.



- **Lab Results:** View lab results, height, weight, BMI and vitals. Date range defaults to the last documented result.
- Documents: View, download and print ambulatory patient summary, discharge instructions, patient education handouts and inpatient summary.
- Medications: Access list of current medications or request current medication refills. You will need to select the prescribing physician, indicate how you would like to be contacted and select or enter your pharmacy.
- 4 Procedures: View list of all patient procedures performed.
- 5 Visit Summaries: View, download and send visit care summaries or personal health records to participating organizations or any email address.
- 6 Radiology: View or download all imaging reports.
- 7 Clinical Notes: View or download office visit notes. Please allow up to 7-10 days for office visit notes to appear after appointment.
- Microbiology: View culture results related to microorganisms. Commonly ordered results found here include blood, urine, stool, wound and sputum.
- COVID Center: View details related to COVID-19, including testing and vaccinations.
- 10 Family History: View details about a patient's family members and their medical conditions/diseases.
- Social History: View details about a patient's habits and lifestyle choices, including alcohol and tobacco use, living situation and marital status.
